General Notes

- 1. The final grade in all planters must be 1" below the adjoining hardscape surfaces.
- 2. Minimize the use of existing Railroad ties by modifying grade where possible. Railroad ties can be stockpiled on site for later use.
- 3. All flowers will be planted on 12" centers using a 4" pots or larger. The flowers will be planted in solid groups of color.
- 4. Group shrubs in odd numbers 3 and 5 of the same species.
- 5. Planting holes for all shrubs should not be any deeper than the root mass of the plant. The planting hole needs to be twice the diameter of the rootball. Back fill material will be a 50/50 mix of native soil and planter mix.
- 6. Irrigation needs to be supplied to all plants utilizing existing irrigation.
- 7. Country Manor retaining walls must be built to the manufacturers specs.
